\* These are the RPs remaining after the mandatory allocations in support of the European theatre. Mandatory allocations are shown on the table; mandatory RPs may not be reduced or reassigned (41.78), but may be increased with discretionary RPs (subject to the normal rules on RP allocation). Each mandatory RP in a production project is assumed to generate one increment (regardless of the number of breakthroughs) for the European theater; additional RPs may be added to generate increments for use in the Pacific, but the cost progression for any Pacific increments begins after the European increments and is based on the actual number of breakthroughs obtained. (Exceptions: 3 RPs in 1941 ASW FP is assumed to generate two increments; 5 RPs in 1945 Military Production, 1946 Air Production, and 1946 Military Production are assumed to generate four increments in each project.)

† Do not roll for Harbor Attack in 1939 or 1940; these two RPs are assumed to generate a result used in Europe in Winter 1940. Only one other naval research project may be rolled in 1939. Beginning in 1941, RPs may be allocated normally to Harbor Attack, and any results obtained may be used in the Pacific, with a modifier for one prior Harbor Attack in Europe.
